

LOUISIANA RECOVERY AND REBUILDING CONFERENCE

November 10-12, New Orleans

November 4, 2005 - A visioning conference for the rebuilding and recovery of Louisiana will be held in New Orleans November 10-12, 2005. The conference is sponsored by the American Institute of Architects in collaboration with the American Planning Association and the National Trust for Historic Preservation. The three day effort will focus on number of planning, design, community development, infrastructure and economic issues including historic resources and preservation. The conference is intended to serve as an initial step in the comprehensive planning process in the rebuilding effort.
