

## **PRESIDENT ANNOUNCES INTENDED APPOINTEES TO ADVISORY COUNCIL**

3/30/06 - On March 27th, the President announced his intention to appoint four individuals to the Advisory Council on Historic Preservation for the remainder of a four-year term expiring June 10, 2009. These include:

- John L. Nau, III of Texas to be designated Chair upon appointment (General Public). Mr. Nau has been the chairman of the Advisory Council since 2000 and has been highly effective in making preservation a priority with the Administration.
- D. Franklin Arey, III, of Arkansas (General Public). Mr. Arey worked for the Arkansas State Historic Preservation Office; consequently he is a preservationist and is familiar with Section 106.
- Mayor Alan Autry, of Fresno California. Fresno is a Preserve America community and has had a historic district commission for over 25 years.
- Governor Matt Blunt, of Missouri. Missouri leads the country in its use of the federal historic preservation rehabilitation tax credit.
