

## **Bush Nominates Bomar To Head National Park Service**

September 15, 2006 - President Bush nominated Mary T. Bomar to be the next Director of the National Park Service on September 5th to replace outgoing director Fran Mainella. Bomar brings considerable managerial experience and expertise with historic sites to the job having formerly served as superintendent of Independence National Historical Park in Philadelphia and as assistant superintendent at the San Antonio Missions National Historical Park.

Bomar's nomination will be subject to Senate approval. The Senate Committee on Energy and Natural Resources has scheduled a confirmation hearing on the Bomar nomination for September 21st.
