National Park System Advisory Board Adopts Recommendations to Improve Federal Rehab Tax Credit Program

Last year, the National Park System Advisory Board, which advises the Director of the National Park Service and the Secretary of the Interior on matters relating to the National Park Service, established a nine-member committee to evaluate the administration of the Federal Historic Rehabilitation Tax Credit Program. National Trust Vice President for Public Policy, Emily Wadhams, served on this committee which made recommendations on improving the administration of the Federal Historic Rehabilitation Tax Credit Program to make it more user-friendly and to clarify the process. These recommendations were adopted by the Advisory Board on September 15th.
