Since 1985, Preservation Maryland has presented awards to individuals and organizations recognizing their exemplary contributions to preserving Maryland's rich and diverse heritage. We are currently seeking nominations of candidates for this year's Historic Preservation Awards to be presented at our Annual Program on November 9, 2011.



The Volunteer Award recognizes individuals, such as these, who were instrumental in the restoration of the Wye Grist Mill.

AWARD CATEGORIES

PRESIDENT'S AWARD

Presented to recognize exceptional leadership and commitment to preserving Maryland's rich and diverse heritage.

Nominations will be evaluated based on the length and nature of service or project, record of achievement, and the nominee's overall impact on the statewide preservation movement.

STEWARDSHIP AWARD

Presented to individuals, organizations, or projects to recognize exemplary stewardship of Maryland's historic buildings, collections, landscapes, and archeological sites.

Nominations will be evaluated based on the degree to which the project conforms to applicable professional standards, such as the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties, and the degree to which the project has successfully protected a historic resource from harm. Nominated projects should have been completed within the last two years.

VOLUNTEER AWARD

Presented to an individual or organization to recognize outstanding volunteer contributions to historic preservation in Maryland.

Nominations will be evaluated based on the extent to which the individual or group's preservation project made a substantial contribution to saving historic resources in Maryland.

PHOENIX AWARD

Presented to individuals, organizations, or projects to recognize excellence in revitalization of historic resources.

Nominations will be evaluated based on the nominees' commitment to historic preservation and community revitalization.

ELIGIBILITY

Individuals, non-profit and for-profit organizations, and government agencies are eligible to receive Preservation Maryland's Historic Preservation Awards. Nominations submitted but not selected in previous years may be resubmitted.

NOMINATION REQUIREMENTS

- A completed nomination form.
- A concise narrative of 500 words or less about the individual or group being nominated, their accomplishments and contributions to the field of historic preservation in the state of Maryland (CD or electronic version of the narrative in MS Word format).
- At least 5-10 photos (in jpeg or tiff format, 300 dpi or greater, on CD).
- Supporting materials, copies of publications, newspaper articles.
- Letters of support from local preservation organizations or elected officials, brochures, or website articles.
- All materials submitted will become the property of Preservation Maryland.
